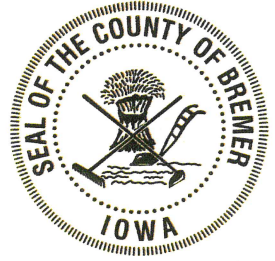

**Constitutional Amendment**

Shall the following amendment to the  
Constitution be adopted?

1

Summary: Provides that the right of the  
people of Iowa to keep and bear arms  
shall not be infringed. The sovereign  
state of Iowa affirms and recognizes the  
right to keep and bear arms as a  
fundamental right. Any and all  
restrictions of this right shall be subject  
to strict scrutiny.

Full Text:

Article I of the Constitution of the State  
of Iowa is amended by adding the  
following new section: Right to keep and  
bear arms. Sec. 1A. The right of the  
people to keep and bear arms shall not  
be infringed. The sovereign state of  
Iowa affirms and recognizes this right to  
be a fundamental individual right. Any  
and all restrictions of this right shall be  
subject to strict scrutiny.
