City of Waverly Public Measure A

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Summary: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Waverly effective July 1, 2024.

The use of the one percent (1%) local option sales and services tax shall be changed in the City of Waverly effective July 1, 2024.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief.

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are:

100%

for streets and bridges; trail, river, park, golf, or pool related improvements and infrastructure; and public safety vehicles and related equipment.

CURRENT USES OF THE TAX:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows:

100% for streets and bridges; trail, river or park related improvements and infrastructure; and public safety vehicles and related equipment.
